Grading Policy

Students will be evaluated on written and performance assessments aligning with our Essential Learnings for band. You can find a copy of our EL Scales on cpmsband.com. Students are ENCOURAGED to do re-do/re-takes for each assessment until skills are mastered. Performance Assessments must be mastered by the corresponding concert dates.

Materials Needed for Class

All students must have their instrument, band books, ***music in a binder***, Chromebook, and a pencil for class every day.

All brass players must have valve oil and slide grease.

All Woodwinds must have at least 4 working reeds for every class.

Band Opportunities

ISSMA Concert Band Contest: Each year the students perform at the ISSMA Concert Band Contest for 3 judges. The students are evaluated on many different categories and receive a Gold, Silver, Bronze or Participation rating. ***This is a required after school/evening performance on either a Friday night or Saturday morning.***

Solo and Ensemble: students are ***encouraged*** but not required to participate in Solo and Ensemble contest. Students learn a solo (by themselves) or an ensemble (with several other students of like instruments) to perform for a judge at another school on Saturday February 3, 2024 and will receive helpful feedback and a medal for their performance. Transportation of students and instruments is not provided.

Private Lessons: Private lessons instruction is available. There are many virtual options for private lessons available to accommodate during this time. It generally ranges from \$20-\$30 for a half hour weekly lesson. Please contact a director if you are interested (kbriel@cpcsc.k12.in.us)

IBA All-Region Honor Band: All Region Honor Band is a group of students from the area nominated by their band directors and selected by a committee. It is a high honor to perform in this group. Many students that participate in private lessons or Solo and Ensemble are selected.

Jazz Band (and Pep Band): Jazz band is an extra-curricular band. More information will be coming soon about a schedule and participation in the Jazz band. It is highly encouraged to participate!

Band Council: CPMS Band students can apply to be a part of the CPMS Band Council. These students will receive basic leadership training, help advocate for our band program within the school and community, plus assist with our beginning band instrument try-on nights.

Prop Team: Any 8th grader interested in traveling to football games and contests with the WCHS Marching Band to help with Props can sign-up for Prop Team in the fall.
